Practical advice for feeding Koi carp

The composition of feed and the nature of the feeding are key factors that influence the health and colour of Koi carp. All Koi carp fans know that Koi carp always beg for feed, however you shouldn't be led into always giving in to this, as over feeding quickly leads to ill health and puts an unnecessary strain on the filter. When it comes to the frequency of feeding, the 'less is better' principle applies.

As such, if possible, it is recommended to spread the feed quantity using 3-4 feed rations instead of the entire quantity in one go. This allows the feed to be ingested better and the strain on the filter is spread over the day. Feed which has not been ingested after 5 minutes is excess feed and only serves to put unnecessarily strain on the filter and impair the water quality.

The ingestion of feed by Koi carp very much depends on the temperature. In the case of temperatures below 8 °C, feeding should be stopped altogether.

In the case of high temperatures (in summer), care should be taken that there is always adequate oxygen dissolved in the water. Otherwise, this will almost certainly lead to the Koi carp becoming ill. The greater that the temperature is, the less oxygen saturation in the water there is and, in addition, the greater the metabolic activity / need for oxygen in the Koi carp.

If necessary, it is possible to occasionally stop the feeding for a few days altogether. This does not damage the fish.

The pellet size to be fed directly relates to the size of the Koi carp, wherein the breeder should base the quantities he supplies on the smallest Koi carp in the pond. This is because large Koi

carp can ingest small feed with no problems, however small Koi carp have problems ingesting large pellets and this restricts their growth.

The quality and composition of the feed should be adjusted to reflect the seasons. As such, it is possible to start in spring (at low temperatures) with an easy to digest feed such as Wheat Germ and as soon as the temperatures permit, then change the feed to one containing increased fat. This way, the energy consumed in winter will be replaced again. The feed for the summer months should have a higher protein content which promotes good growth. The feed can now contain colour intensifying additives such as Spirulina or paprika essences.

In autumn, the feed can once again have a higher proportion of fat so that the Koi carp can create a store of energy for the colder months.

The additional use of feed additives is recommended.

As it is not possible to process all the necessary ingredients in feed at the same time (due to production constraints, compatibility, shelf life,...), I recommend the use of feed additives for a healthy and balanced diet. This helps the Koi carp to make better use of the ingredients and avoid the signs of deficiency which often lead to illness.
